Premium Chardonnay 14 / 50

Aromas of peach jam, pears and orange. Medium body with flavors of lemon and toasty vanilla with a long and rich finish.

Italian Super Tuscan 15 / 65

Intense red wine, with aromas of plum, blackberry fruits and spices. The mouth has great impact, the attack is thick and sweet, the progression is rich of nuances. The ending is pleasant, with hints of chocolate and liquorice.

Top Pinot Noir 15 / 59

A graceful, pretty wine, dark-fruited red; though it's full-bodied and lush, it still shows classic Pinot Noir structure and elegance.

Full Body Meritage 15 / 59

Our Meritage is deep ruby-red in the glass, with aromas of black currant and cassis.

This seductive wine is lusciously textured with a myriad of black and purple fruit delivering a smooth, elegant finish.

Premium Cabernet Sauvignon 15 / 59

Presents dusty chocolate and black cherry aromas layered with subtle floral notes and oak. This is an elegantly structured wine with silkiness through the mild palate and a persistent, juicy finish.
